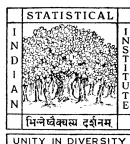

Dear Candidate,

Congratulations! I am glad to inform you that based on your performance in the written tests and the interview you have been selected to join the **51th batch** of our **B.Stat (Hons.) programme**. As you know, our B.Stat (Hons.) is a three-year programme. You will be admitted to the First Year of the programme for the academic year 2010-2011, for which the **classes will start from 5 July 2010** at the Kolkata campus of our Institute. Your admission is conditional on your satisfying the necessary eligibility conditions and also being certified medically fit by our Medical Officer.

If you belong to **SC/ST/OBC/PH** category, you will be provided one-way sleeper/second class railway fare between your home station and Kolkata by the shortest route, on production of proper supporting documents in original and Xerox copy of your railway ticket.

You are instructed to report to our Medical Welfare Unit located in our ISI Hostel campus (205, B. T. Road, Kolkata-700 108) on any day during 1-2 July, 2010 between 10.30 a.m. - 1.00 p.m. or 3.30p.m. – 5.30 p.m. for obtaining your medical fitness certificate. **Please bring with you recent clinical test reports of your Blood Sugar (P.P.) and Urine (routine examination) done very recently at reputed and standard clinical laboratory.** Our Medical Officer will need to examine you and your reports in order to issue a Medical Fitness Certificate.

After obtaining your Medical Fitness Certificate, you along with your guardian will need to report to the Dean's Office on the 5th Floor of the S. N. Bose Bhavan at our 203, B. T. Road, Kolkata-700 108 campus on any day during 1-2 July, 2010 between 10.30 a.m. - 1.30 p.m. or 2.30p.m. – 5.30 p.m. **Please bring your mark-sheets and certificates (both original and attested copies) of all the examinations you have passed along with supporting documents of SC/ST/OBC/PH category (both original and attested copies) and 3 copies of recent passport size photographs.** If you have appeared for the qualifying examinations (Higher Secondary or equivalent) but the results are not yet declared, you will be admitted provisionally. The provisional admission will be confirmed only on receipt of evidence of your passing the qualifying examinations.

At the time of admission, you will have to pay a Library Deposit of Rs.2000.00. Limited Hostel accommodation for students are available in our campus. While allotting hostel accommodation, outstation students will be given preference. **If you are provided with Hostel accommodation, you will have to pay a deposit Rs. 605.00.**

Soon after joining, you will be required to appear in a test for English with a view to decide whether you will have to take a Remedial English course in the first semester.

On confirmation of your admission, you will get a monthly stipend of Rs. 800.00 plus an annual contingency grant of Rs.1500.00 as per rules. The stipend is given initially for one semester and is renewed every semester based on your performance. If you leave in the middle of the programme, you will be required to refund the entire amount received as stipend and contingency grant. The stipend for the period July – September 2010 will be paid along with the stipend of October 2010. You should, therefore, come prepared to meet your expenses during the initial three-month period.
