The International Conference on Pattern Recognition and Machine Intelligence (PRemi) is one of the prestigious and leading international conferences in the areas of pattern recognition, machine learning, data mining, knowledge discovery, and related fields. The primary goal of the conference is to provide a platform for presenting state-of-the-art scientific results, encourage academic and industrial interactions, and promote collaborative research activities in Pattern Recognition, Machine Intelligence, and related fields, involving scientists, engineers, professionals, researchers and students from India and abroad. The conference is held biennially to make it an ideal platform for people to share their views and experiences in the said areas.

PRemi'23 is the tenth conference of this series, which will be held during December 12 -15, 2023 in Kolkata, a massive metropolitan area called 'the city of joy', situated in the Eastern part of India. In association with this conference, proposals are invited for special sessions of 1-1.5 hrs. on emerging topics in the domain of pattern recognition and machine learning from active researchers and engaging presenters, affiliated with academia and/or industry. Please read carefully the submission guidelines below before submitting your proposal.

Proposal submission guidelines:

Each special session proposal should include the following:

1. Title of the Special Session
2. Session Organizers (max 2): names, email addresses, and affiliations
3. Abstract (max 200 words)
4. Background and Justification (max 350 words) which should indicate i) the motivation behind the special session, and ii) the potential impact of the committed papers in the proposed session.
5. Details of **at least three (03)** Contributing Papers (titles, authors, affiliations, and short abstracts).
6. Details of Reviewers (at least 3): names, email addresses, and affiliations

Proposals for the special sessions should be mailed to any one of the Special Session Chairs (kuntalghos@gmail.com, monidipadas@hotmail.com).

Proposal selection/evaluation:

The evaluation of the special session proposals will be done based on: **i) the proposed topic, ii) the impact and expected quality of the contributing papers, and iii) the suitability of the proposed list of reviewers.** After the acceptance of the proposal, the key role of the proposer would be to take the lead in collecting the special session papers and subsequent review of the same along with two other reviewers from the PRemi'23 technical review committee. However, acceptance of a special session proposal does not guarantee final occurrence of the event. **All submitted papers corresponding to a proposed special session will be rigorously reviewed in the same way as that of the regular track papers. In case the number of accepted papers is less than three (03), the special session would be cancelled.** During the special session event, **the proposer would be invited to chair the session.** Further, as a special session chair, he/she would be exempted from conference registration fee, and local hospitality will also be taken care of by the conference Organizing Committee.
